The deep-hued juice in the glass yields a robustly pretty nose of red berries and flowers. On the palate, the wine exhibits a well-structured, yet crunchy freshness that delights the senses. The length and finesse in this wine are absolutely delicious, with ample acidity, bright fruit, floral hints, and mineral undertones. Overall, a delightful and well-crafted expression of Gamay that is sure to impress any wine lover."

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

The Chenas is a prime example of bush vine Gamay, grown in the intense granite soils of the Cru. The grapes are hand-harvested when they reach their ideal balance between sugar and acidity, and then brought to the cellar in LanciÃ© where natural fermentation takes place in both stainless and cement vessels with whole clusters.
