Made in the isolated Chañarmuyo Valley, where the local village now lives from the winery's production. This is an equal cuvée of Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% of which is aged in new wood. Fresh, crunchy and well balanced, it's very much a high-altitude wine with vivid berry fruit, spicy oak and appealing minerality.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Cabernet Sauvignon provides both structure (acidic and tannic) and aromatic complexity (cassis, cedar, tobacco). The Cabernet Franc brings a lifted, slightly more floral aroma, and a hint of spice on the palate. You will fall in love with the dark currant and rich black fruit with notes of toasty oak spice.
