Notes of baked blackberry, clove, and purple flowers intertwined with a subtle hint of mandarin on the nose. The palate is lively and energetic, showcasing flavors of blackberry and plum melded with a taut and intricate framework that is approachable yet vibrant. Crafted from 100% bush vine Gamay, this wine underwent whole cluster fermentation in both concrete and stainless vats, then aged for six months in concrete before being bottled.

## WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

---

The aromas are explosive with mountain blueberry, ripe red cherry, the crust of a mixed berry pie, clove, orange zest, and fresh cut flowers. In the mouth the fruit hits with brightness, yet has a bit of density behind it to fill the palate from front to back, all to be lifted again in a finish of lively acidity, soft tannin, and lingering red fruit.
