

Bad Boy takes its name from the well-earned moniker of Jean Luc, who is affectionately known as the Bad Boy of St. Emilion for marching to the beat of his own drum. This value wine from the Right Bank drinks well young and should be decanted for best expression.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Bad Boy comes from a terroir of clay and limestone soils, similar to what you find in many St. Emilion vineyards. It has a fragrant, floral bouquet this year with scents of black cherries, incense and a touch of vanilla pod. The palate is medium-bodied with firm tannin, fresh in the mouth with a citrus line of acidity, slightly granular in texture.
