### EXPERT NOTES

Rioja Alavesa is the smallest of the three wine-producing sub-regions in Rioja, Spain and is situated to the north of the Ebro River. It is the closest of the three sub-zones to the Atlantic Ocean and thus the one most influenced by its cooling effects. This winery's unique style is a reflection of its superior plots within the foothills of the Sierra Cantabria, and is distinguished by its use of stringent grape selection methods and use of new French Oak barrels.

### WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

25 months of aging in French Oak has resulted in a mature, complex and meaty red wine. With elegant aromas of ripe red fruit, and spicy notes on a very clean toasted base note it shows a unique delicacy. On the palate it is fleshy and full, with an incredibly fresh finish.
